CAMP at Paws In Progress

What to expect when your dog comes to camp:

- Camp at Paws In Progress is to give your dog a safe place to stay that maintains your dogs training.
- Every day they will practice waiting at doorways and have the training they already know reinforced as it presents opportunities in daily life.
- Due to different training levels, daily schedules and personality conflicts not everyone will be included in every activity.
- Some days are very busy days for your pup and other days are for rest and learning to chill.

Who cares for your dog:

- On Occasion for a day, couple hours or an evening a Professional pet sitter, Dog Trainer or someone specifically trained by Eleza will fill in when needed. These professionals have been trained to the Paws In Progress standards to still keep your dogs accountable to their training and polite behavior.

What to bring:

- Food (Please include an extra day or 2 just incase your plans get delayed) A note about how much at each meal and specifics is helpful.
- · Leash & ALL Training Collars
- Treat Donations (Welcomed not required.)

Pre-Requirements / Health Safety:

- Your dog can't have been to a dog park, doggy daycare or boarding facility within 2 weeks prior to staying at Paws In Progress. Our goal is to reduce the potential risk of a dog bringing in an illness.
- Honor System
 - If your dog has an upset tummy, runny poop, personality / behavioral changes, or on new medication **please** communicate this before your dogs stay.
 - A vet visit may be required before their stay for symptoms that pose a potential concern to the health and safety of other dogs.
 - If you've seen a change in behavior, or your dog has had a traumatic experience (example: attacked by dog..) since i saw them last, you need to communicate this **BEFORE** their stay.

Pick-up / Drop-off

Book a 15min appointment window.

For Example: If drop off is Friday and pick up Saturday that is 2 days regardless of pick up and drop off times.

Alumni Day Camp \$80/day

Daily Activities at Eleza's Property to keep them mentally and physically fulfilled may include: Teaching a trick, a social day, pool time, confidence building on Agility Equipment, Game of Fetch, Learning how to walk on the treadmill etc. All dogs get nap time throughout the day in their own crate/pen.

Day Adventure \$120/day

An Off the property Adventure at least 2hrs out on the trails.

Adventures include practicing car manners, leash manners, some duration commands and off leash fun while out exploring the world with other dogs on a guided adventure.

Limited Spots available.

Must be booked at least 1 week in advance to allow for scheduling.

Multi day stays can be a mix of Day Camp + Adventure Days

If Eleza plans a camping trip you may be notified and given the option for your dog to stay at camp at the normal rate, or to tag along on a camping adventure. In this case consecutive days of adventure camp may be required for overnight adventure trips.
